#### GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Contractor shall comply with all applicable codes and regulations in all phases of this project
- A certificate of insurance will be submitted prior to contract, showing that the contractor has Workmen's Compensation as well as an umbrella liability in an amount not less than \$1,000,000
- Permit and Codes: General contractor shall be responsible for seeing that all licensed, permits, fees, etc. required for all work involved have been purchased.
- Contractor will get all subcontractors (plumber, electrician, and anyone else involved in project)
- Contractor will need bids from heating and air, plumber, and electricians

#### MATERIALS

- All walls will be 2x6 with 24' center and ceiling will be made of 2x10
- There will be a drop down cell with LED lighting
- Flooring will be vinyl composition tile, shall be 1/8" x 7" x 36"
- Toilet will be ADA compliance. Grab bars will be 14 gauge type 304 stainless steel exposed surfaces, shall be satin finish with texture grip
- Heating, cooling, and ventilating work shall include labor, all materials and equipment to install all systems necessary to provide heating, cooling and ventilation to proposed facility
- Plumbing and electrical work needed for washer and dryer set up
- Toilet partition to be standard: can be metal or wood
- R 19 insulation on exterior walls
- FRP panels 3ft high on walls. Water resistant
- Stalls around toilets will be wood and will be finished
- Doors need to be solid wood
- Deck will be built above for storage. Deck will need 4ft. handrails all the way around
