**BALLOT MATERIALS:** The printer agrees to furnish all ballot stock and other materials

and equipment necessary to print digital ballots, and to incur any expense relating to the delivery of ballots to the Election Board. (Additional shipping costs may be included non orders

of small quantities of ballots.)

**SPECIFICATIONS:** The "Oklahoma Specifications for Digital Ballot Printing,"

Is attached and shall be considered a part of this contract. All

ballots must be prepared in accordance with these

specifications, and the Election Board is not required to accept

any ballots not printed accordingly.

**DELIVERY DATES:** The delivery dates specified by the Election Board are

critical. Any deviation must be approved by the Election Board Secretary. Failure to deliver all ballots by the dates specified shall result in a fine being assessed to the printer in the amount of (\$50.00) fifty dollars per day for each day after the deadline specified by the County Election Board.

Delivery dates are listed below:

- Absentee ballots shall be delivered no later than 50 days before an election held on the same date as a regular or
