The Commissioners may take action with respect to recommendations of the hospital trust authority to modify, amend, or possibly terminate the sublease agreement of MHTC with SRP Guymon, LLC; and/or consider and possibly take action to modify, amend, or possibly terminate the lease agreement with Memorial Hospital of Texas County Authority.)
