Johnson reported that the health fair at the hospital had a great turn out. They were planning for 100 and got 95 so they were pleased. Thanks to the lab techs from Liberal and Hugoton volunteering to help with it. The rural health program has been applied for from the Federal Government and that will be a great help. The Mobile Smiles is open, and the hospital is doing the scheduling for that at this time. The Telehealth for stroke victims is ready to be used. The cost report is done and waiting on the audit. They have \$1.4 million in the bank and are caught up on accounts payable. Staff is doing well, and we have \$300,000 for payroll. They will request the funds to pay for the roof that is finished.
