Leiter reported that they are working on another bid for the roof project due to the guy they have now is unable to pass his test to get his license. They will have a request this week for the AC units. They are working on a draft for the amount the payments will be for the hospital loan once the 2019 loan is paid off. Hospital Board Meeting will be June 30<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.
