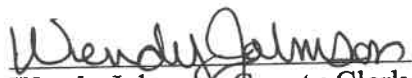
Discussion on yard and courthouse parking lot:

Buddy Leach, District Attorney, was absent.

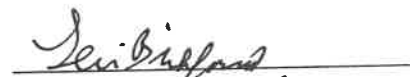

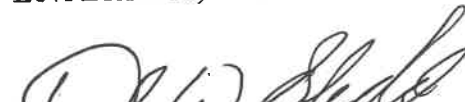
