

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS  
(RESOLUTION # 127-20-21)

Dist. D2

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [OKLA. STAT. Tit. 18, § 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA STAT. Tit. 69, § 1401 (1991)] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, TCEC has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit:

*Commencing at a point 33.00' East of the SW corner of Section 14, T3N-R15ECM; Thence North 890.00' to a new Ductile Iron Pole; Thence West crossing Mile 34 a distance of 66.00' into the SE/4 of Section 15, T3N-R15ECM, Texas County, Oklahoma*

WHEREAS, petitioner must meet all requirements of the permit.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

All requirements of the permit must be met and it shall be bored.
