CANCELLATION OF TEXAS COUNTY BURN BAN

Whereas; The Texas County Board of Commissioners pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by Section 16-26.B of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes, do hereby proclaim that extreme fire danger **no longer exists** in Texas County. This situation (as defined in Section 16-26.B1.a-d, Title 2, O.S.) has been verified by a documented concurrence of the majority of the County's fire chiefs, or their designees.


