WHEREAS the elected officials of Texas County have determined that an Employee Personnel Policy Handbook will significantly improve communications between the County and its employees, and

WHEREAS the elected officials of Texas County have determined that a written Employee Personnel Policy Handbook promotes fairness in employment and assists in the prevention of discrimination in employment of any nature.

WHEREAS the County Commissioners have previously adopted and implemented a written Employee Policy Handbook; having now reviewed updates and modifications to the same with the elected officials of Texas County; having received the approval of a majority of the elected officials of Texas County of proposed updates and modifications; and being wholly satisfied that such updates and revisions are in furtherance of the objectives of said Handbook and in the best interest of Texas County and its employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to Okla. Stat. Ann. tit. 19, Section 339, Texas County, by a unanimous vote of the County Commissioners, hereby adopts the 2017 revised "Employee Personnel Policy Handbook of Texas County."
