VEHICLE POLICY  
JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER


**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County has discussed the need for a policy regarding the use of personal vehicles and charging of mileage for business trips for the Texas County Juvenile Detention Center and the use of a County owned vehicle and

**WHEREAS**, there has been no previous clarification for the use of such vehicles,

**THEREFORE**, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, that in-county business trips shall be limited to once a week for the purpose of delivering paperwork to the Texas County Courthouse and the purchase of supplies needed for the operation of the Texas County Juvenile Detention Center and that said trips shall be made in a vehicle furnished by the Board of County Commissioners to the Texas County Juvenile Detention Center as long as said vehicle is mechanically sound and in good running order. Said vehicle shall also be used for all in-state business trips for training purposes or required meetings. All fuel and maintenance costs of said vehicle shall be paid from the Juvenile Detention Maintenance and Operations account. Vehicle shall not be used for any personal use. In the event said vehicle is not in good running order, mileage will be paid to the individual making said trips in his/her personal vehicle at the current rate allowed by the State of Oklahoma at the time of the trip.


**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that Texas County does hereby adopt this **VEHICLE POLICY** for the Texas County Juvenile Detention Center and it shall go into effect December 9, 2014.
