RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS
(RESOLUTION # 72-11-12)

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [OKLA. STAT. Tit. 18, § 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA STAT. Tit. 69, § 1401 (1991)] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, PTCI has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit: Starting 1600 feet west of the SE corner Sec.2,T2N-R14ECM going west for a distance of 1000'. Then a crossing from SE/4 Sec.2,T2N-R14ECM to NE/4 Sec.11,T2N-R14ECM then east for 100 feet along the NE/4 Sec.11,T2N-R14ECM. SE/4 Sec.2,T2N-R14ECM going north along Carol St. Contryman Sub-Divison. Up to Arapaho Drive, Indian Hills Estates Sub Divison. Then west along Arapaho Drive for a distance of 2300 feet. SE/4 Sec.2,T2N-R14ECM going west along the south side of SW/4 Sec.2-T2N-R14ECM. Also along the south side of SE/4 Sec.3,T2N-R14ECM for a distance of 2600 feet.

WHEREAS, petitioner must meet all requirements of the permit.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

All requirements of the permit must be met and it shall be bored.
