RESOLUTION # 92-11-12

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma are required and have the power to make all orders respecting reapportionment of County Commissioners' districts pursuant to Title 19, OS, Paragraph 321:


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, do hereby give notice that the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County have divided Texas County into three compact districts, numbered respectively one, two, and three. Texas County has been reapportioned following the 2010 Federal Decennial Census showing clearly visible, definable and observable physical boundaries of each County Commissioner district. Said proposed maps defining boundaries are on file in the Texas County Election Board office for public inspection.

District #1- From Mile 42 (NS097) go southwest on US Hwy. 54 to Mile 32 (NS087). Go south on Mile 32 to EW023.5. Go west on EW023.5 to the intersection of SH136 and S. 12th Street. Continue west on S. 12th Street to S. Crumley Street. Go north on S. Crumley Street to US Hwy. 54. Follow US Hwy. 54 northeast to Mile 32. Go north on Mile 32 to the railroad tracks of Union Pacific Railroad. Follow the railroad tracks northeast to Mile 42.

District #3- From Mile 24 (NS079) go northeast following the railroad tracks of Union Pacific Railroad to the intersection of the City Limits of Guymon, OK. From that point go north to W. Indian Hills Street (EW022). From that point go east to the intersection of W. Indian Hills and Sunset Drive. From that intersection go straight east to the intersection of Sunset Lane and S. 5th Street. Go east on S. 5th Street to S. Beaver Street. Go north on S. Beaver Street to First Street. Go west on First Street to Sunset Lane. Go north on Sunset Lane to N. 19th Street (Tiger Blvd.). Go east on N. 19th Street to N. Main Street. Go south on Main Street to S. 12th Street. Go west on S. 12th Street (EW023.5) to Mile 30 (NS085). Go north on Mile 30 to US Hwy. 54. Go southwest on US Hwy. 54 to Mile 24.

THEREFORE, after due consideration and deeming it to be in the best interest of Texas County, Oklahoma, the Board of County Commissioners does hereby pass and approve the above Resolution in regular session on the 19th day of September, 2011.
