

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS
(RESOLUTION # 197-10-11)

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [OKLA. STAT. Tit. 18, § 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA STAT. Tit. 69, § 1401 (1991)] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, PTCT has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit: Starting approx. 4594' south of the junction of State Hwy 3/412 and Co Rd Hwy 10
A proposed bore to be made from east Right-of-Way Sec 27 T2N R19E to the west Right of Way Sec 28 T2N R19E.

WHEREAS, petitioner must meet all requirements of the permit.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

All requirements of the permit must be met and it shall be bored.
