

RESOLUTION # 207-10-11


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma has the power to declare an emergency under the Emergency Operations Plan.


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma has the authority and power to impose a burn ban within Texas County, and whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma has declared that an emergency situation has arisen due to drought conditions within Texas County.


THEREFORE, after due consideration, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma is implementing a ban on discharging of fireworks for the rural areas outside the city limits of any incorporated community of Texas County.

Any willful violation of this ban will cause severe financial sanctions to be imposed upon the violator to include, but not limited to, actual costs incurred to extinguish a fire and any civil remedies pursued by victims of such willful negligence or indifference to this resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution was passed and approved in regular session, this 13th day of June, 2011.


