

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS

(RESOLUTION # 43-08-09)

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [OKLA. STAT. Tit. 18, § 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA STAT. Tit. 69, § 1401 (1991)] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment, wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, The City of Guymon has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit:

A 10' waterline easement located in and across the south half of Section 36 T3N R 14E C.M. and the North half of Section 1 T2N R 14E C.M. the centerline of which being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the SW corner of said Section 36; thence S 89°53'45" E along the south line of said Section a distance of 32.80'; thence S 00°00'54" a distance of 28' to the point of beginning; thence N 00°00'54" W a distance of 82.66 to the point of termination of said easement. The basis of bearings for this description is S89°53'45"E along the south line of Section 36 T3N R14E C.M. Texas Co. Oklahoma.

County, Oklahoma, does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

Must meet all requirements of the permit and shall be bored. Set all valves as far back as possible on county right of way
