

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS

(RESOLUTION # 44-08-09)

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [ OKLA. STAT. Tit. 18, § 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA STAT. Tit. 69, § 1401 (1991) ] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment, wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, The City of Guymon has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit:

A 10' waterline easement in and across the North 33' of Section 21 and the South 33' of Section 16 T3N R15E C.M. Texas Co. Oklahoma. The centerline of said easement being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the NE Corner of the NE ¼ corner of the NW ¼ of said Section 21; thence N 89°46'17"W along the north line of said Section a distance of 425.42'; thence S 0°03'05" W a distance of 33.0' to the point of beginning of said easement; thence N 0°03'05"E a distance of 61.00 to the point of termination of said easement. The basis of bearings for this description is N 89° 46' 17" W along the north line of Section 21 T3N R15E C.M. Texas Co. Oklahoma

the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

Must meet all requirements of the permit and it shall be bored. Set all valves as far back as possible on county right of way
