WHEREAS, there being a quorum of the Board present, the following motion was made by Gary Winters and seconded by Ted Keeling, affirmative vote by all; AND,

WHEREAS, HB1176 (CIRB) requires counties to set county priorities for projects, and these projects are currently funded by HB1176:

- 2010 JP 25483 Construction for 11 miles on County Highway 40 beginning @ SH 64 and ending at County Highway 7, District 3 (1<sup>st</sup> priority)
- 2011 JP 25484 Engineering for one bridge 5 miles east & 3.5 miles south of Hardesty. CN 075 N1070E0300003 NBI 16784 37', 30' 29' Steel BM Spans Skew 45. District 1 (2<sup>nd</sup> priority)

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, does declare the following priority project for the HB1176 2013 program year:

- 2013 Engineering of 12 miles on EW-10 from SH-136 east to NS-97. District 2, (3<sup>rd</sup> priority)
