**WHEREAS,** The Interlocal Cooperative Act of Oklahoma Statutes 75 § 1001 et seq. enables county government to cooperate with each other to make the most efficient use of their powers and resources on a basis of mutual advantages; and

**WHEREAS,** The Board of County Commissioners of Texas County authorizes the county to participate in a Circuit Engineering District with other counties who are within their Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma.

**WHEREAS,** The Board of County Commissioners of Texas County desires to enter into an agreement with other counties within ACCO District Eight to help in carrying out the functions delegated by law including, but not limited to, the operation of road maintenance, construction, inspection, purchases and management.

**WHEREAS,** the need exists for The Board of County Commissioners of Texas County renew this resolution yearly to confirm commitment and participation in the program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** The Board of County Commissioners of Texas County hereby agrees to become a party to the agreement establishing the ACCO District Eight Circuit Engineering and to abide by the rules established by the District.
