

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS
RESOLUTION # 28-04-05

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma (OKLA. STAT. tit. 18, §437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA. STAT. tit. 69, § 1401 (1991) provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment, wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, PTCI has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit:

Starting approximately 2,200 feet south of the NW Corner of Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 13 ECM or south of the junction of the junction of Highway 54 and Mile 22. At this point a bore will be placed across County Road 22 from the West Right-of-Way of Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 13 ECM to the East Right of Way of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 13 ECM,

From the Corner of the NE/4 of Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 13 ECM, 1,271 feet to the East, placement of a communication line going east for a distance of 387 feet.

WHEREAS, petitioner must meet all requirements of the permit.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, do hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

All roads are to be bored.
