

RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF UTILITY PERMITS

(RESOLUTION # 35-03-04)

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma [OKLA. STAT. Title 18, §§ 437.2 and 438.4 (1991) and OKLA. STAT. Title 69, §1401 (1991)] provide that rural electric cooperatives, telephone cooperative corporations and public utilities shall have the right-of-way and all easements pertaining thereto for the purpose of erecting poles and posts, attaching equipment, wires and fixtures thereto and laying lines, pipes and conduits under the surface thereof.

WHEREAS, Timberland Gathering & Processing Co., Inc. has requested this Board's approval of placement of utility lines (poles, pipelines, telecommunication lines or power lines) within the County right-of-way at the following location, to-wit:

A point approximately 2,580 feet east of the northwest corner of Section 10 and the southwest corner of Section 3, Township 5 North, Range 17 ECM, Texas County, Oklahoma

WHEREAS, petitioner must meet all requirements of the permit.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma does hereby consent to the placement of a distribution line according to the requirements as set forth in the completed Permit Application attached. With the following special instruction to be included:

Must follow all rules and regulations of
the permit and must also be bonded.
