WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Texas County, Oklahoma, has under its management and control one item of equipment described as follows:

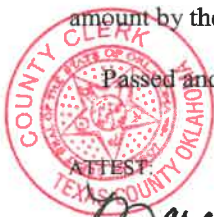
